 Remove garments wearing rubber gloves, rinse thoroughly and then wash with your regular detergent as usual. For tenacious staining repeat process

<u>(!)</u> **Before** use test for colourfastness: apply a small solution amount of an inconspicuous area and leave until dry. If there is no change in colour, continue following the instructions above. Always rinse tested area with warm water per garment care label instructions
